(GA ranks 3rd in the nation in the fresh market sweet corn production.)



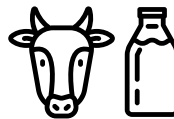
Help make breakfast with a Georgia grown commodity.

Visit a local nursery and select a plant to have in your home or in your yard. (Ornamental horticulture is the 5th highest commodity group in Georgia.)



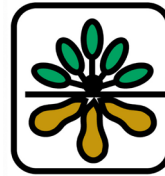
Eat your favorite fruit. (Georgia ranks 4th in the nation in watermelon production.)
